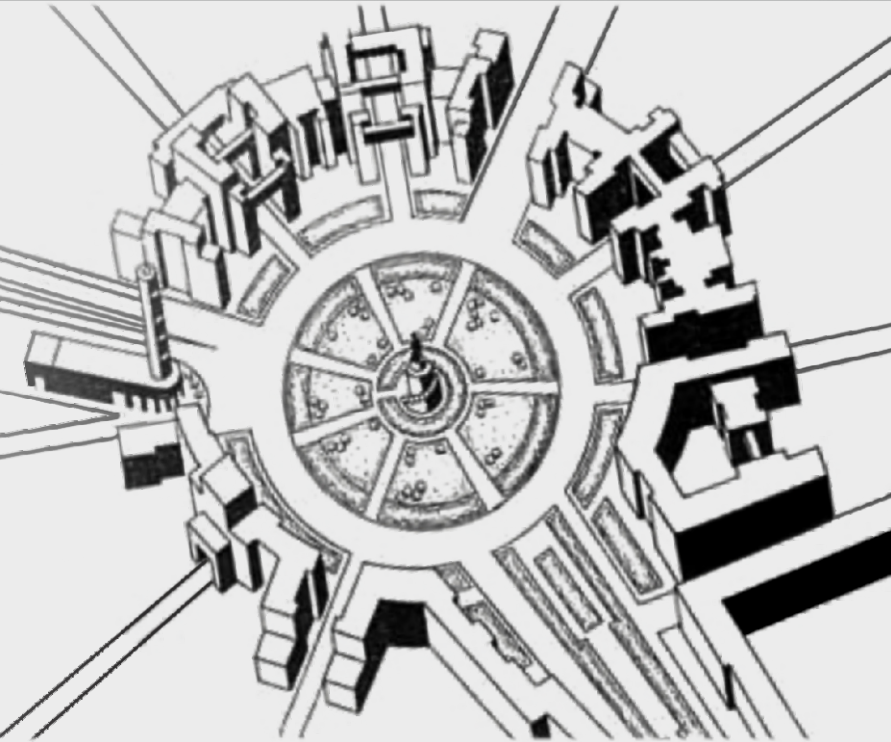


NEW URBANISM IN EASTERN EUROPE —

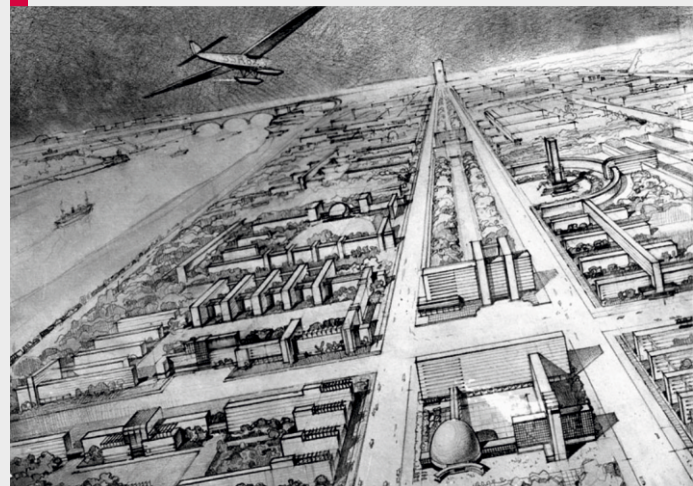
