INFORMATION FOR SPEAKERS

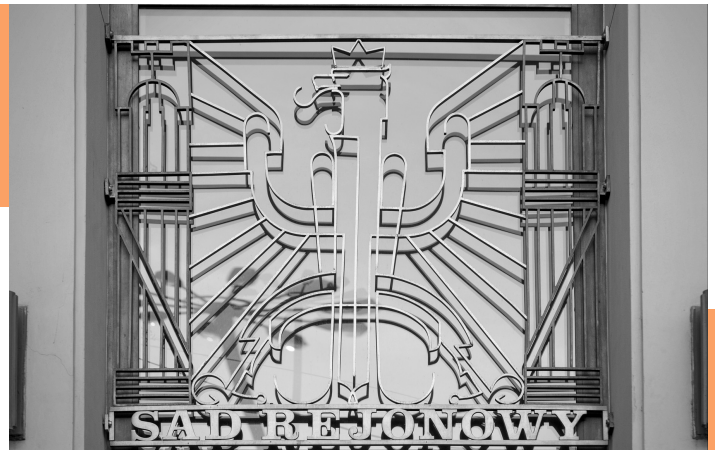
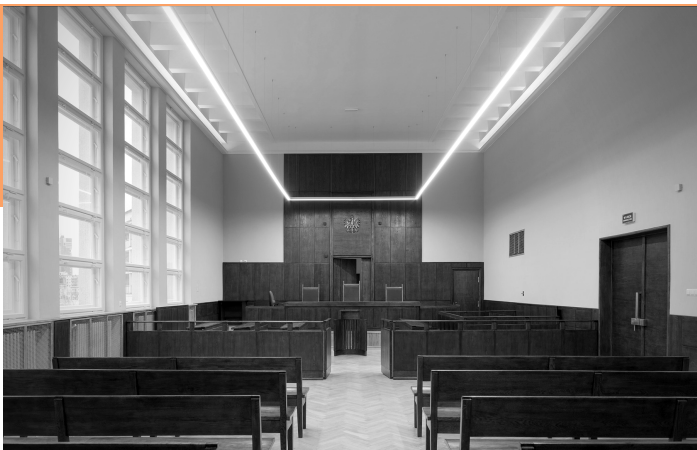
All submitted papers should tackle important issues and be complementary to current knowledge in the field. They are expected to include latest findings of conducted research which were not widely discussed or published so far. New and relevant topics, directly or indirectly connected with the architecture of Gdynia, are also welcome. Authors should have documented achievements (scientific, professional, etc.) related to the thematic scope of the conference. Participants interested in presenting a paper should send their abstracts in English (400-800 words) together with a completed registration form until 31st March 2019. Moreover, a biographical note and a list of important professional achievements should be attached.

Papers to be presented during the conference will be selected by the Scientific Committee. Speakers chosen by the Committee will be required to send text version of planned paper till 31st August 2019 and directly before the conference should provide a bilingual presentation of the speech (presentation time: 20 minutes)
